What is it?

The World Apostolate of Fatima (formerly known as the 'Blue Army'), is a world-wide association of the baptised, approved by the Holy See, who seek to live and spread Our Lady's message.

In England it was approved by the Bishop's Conference of 2004, and is listed in the *Catholic Directory*. On 7th October 2010, the World Apostolate of Fatima was permanently erected as a Public Association of the Faithful by Cardinal Rylko, President of the Pontifical Council for the Laity.

What happened at Fatima?

In 1917 on the 13th of each month from May to October, (but in August it took place on the 19th), Our Lady appeared to the shepherd children Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta, aged from 10 to 7. She gave them a message of peace, conversion and salvation which today is more urgent and relevant than ever.

On October 13th, 70,000 people saw the 'miracle of the sun'. Francisco and Jacinta died within three years, and were beatified in 2000. Lucia became a Carmelite nun, recorded the story of the apparitions in her memoirs, *Fatima in Lucia's Own Words*, published a detailed response to people's questions in May 2000, and died aged 97 on 13th February 2005.

We seek to fulfill the wishes of Jesus (13th June 1917), to make Mary known and loved, fulfill her requests and establish in the world devotion to her Immaculate Heart.
