

#### Feast of the Presentation

Dear Friends,

Sunday is the Feast of the Presentation, which is the official end of Christmastide, forty days after Christmas Day, and a chance for us all to consider how we can dedicate ourselves more fully to God, the Church and Our Lady.

One way of doing this would be to come along, on 22 February, to Westminster Cathedral, London, where there will be Holy Mass to launch the 5-year preparation for the Centenary of the request for Five First Saturdays Devotion.

This event will include a Procession of the Centennial Pilgrim Statue of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (different from the National Statue, since it is focused on the Immaculate Heart and thus also on the First Saturdays), followed by recitation of the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary, and then a talk on the centenary programme, on the themes for the next five years leading to the Centenary year 2025, with Holy Mass 2:45 pm.

And on 29 February there is an NPVS Parish Visitation, at St Joseph's church in Colliers Wood, London, SW19 2JF

Our first Saturday this February falls on the eve of the feast of the Presentation of Lord.

The Gospel for the 40th day of Christmas identifies the first prophecy of the sorrows of Our Lady, "a sword will pierce your own soul."

martyrdom as Co-Redemptrix, with the unique offering of her Son, the Redeemer, to the eternal Father.

The sorrows of Our Lady are the result of the sufferings of her Son and of our sins. Our reparation, through our participation at this First Saturday devotions, allows us to stand by the side of Our Lady, to keep her company and thus to remove the thorns that pierce her Immaculate Heart.

Details of the World Apostolate of Fatima England and Wales National pilgrimage are being finalised, and full information will be available shortly.

But for now, I can tell you that the dates are 9-16 July 2020, that is 7 nights half board at Domus Pacis hotel at a cost of £475, excluding flights. It will be necessary for pilgrims to book these separately, flying from from either Bristol or London Heathrow.

These airports are being used in order to coordinate with the onward buses from Lisbon airport to Fatima.

Also, as was mentioned above, later this month we will have the special launch Mass at Westminster Cathedral to start the 5 year countdown to the centennial celebration of the 1925 apparition of Our Lady to Sr Lucia. This completed the revelation of the First Saturday devotion which was first requested in July 1917.

I look forward very much to seeing you in London.

## St John Bosco and heavenly protection from disease

Today, 31st of January, is the feast of St John Bosco, one of the most marvellous saints in recent church history. He lived during the nineteenth century, when diseases such as cholera were very serious matters.

On one occasion cases of cholera occured in Turin, Italy, where he was based, and as a protection against this he advised that all should strive to live in a state of grace through Confesssion and Holy Communion, and also wear a blessed Marian medal around the neck, plus recite suitable prayers.

This is relevant given the advent of the coronavirus, and we should certainly pray and put our trust in Our Lady's protection from this and similar medical conditions.

We can also pray to Saints Jacinta and Francisco, and Servant of God Sr Lucia for protection from coronavirus and other forms of flu, given that all three suffered in the epidemic of Spanish Flu which killed millions of people in the early twentieth century, at the end of World War I.
