

PLEDGE TO OUR LADY OF FATIMA

Dear Queen and Mother, who promised at Fatima to convert Russia and bring peace to all mankind, in reparation for my sins and the sins of the whole world. I solemnly promise to your Immaculate Heart:

- 1. To offer up every day the sacrifices demanded of my daily duty.
- 2. To pray part of the Rosary * daily while meditating the Mysteries.
- To wear the brown scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel as profession of this promise and as an Act of Consecration to you.
- 4. To accomplish the devotion of the Five First Saturdays of the month, including fifteen minutes meditation on the Mysteries of the Rosary

*Usually understood to mean five decades.

I shall renew this promise often, especially in moments of temptation.

Note: The pledge is not a vow and does not bind under sin. Nevertheless, it is a promise of love, your word to your heavenly Mother.

"Mary's message at Fatima can be synthesised in these clear, initial words of Christ: "The Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the Gospel" (MK. 1.15)"

The World Apostolate of Fatima is a movement of millions of persons throughout the world responding to the requests made by the Blessed Virgin at Fatima, Portugal in 1917. Through the three shepherd children, Our Lady spoke to the whole world. "Do not offend the Lord Our God anymore, because He is already so much offended" (October 13, 1917). She asked for personal conversion, the daily Rosary for world peace, prayers and sacrifices for sinners who have no one to pray for them and reparation to the Eucharistic Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

The Holy Virgin warned "If my requests are heeded, Russia will be converted and there will be peace; If not, she (Russia) will spread her errors throughout the world, causing wars and persecutions of the Church. The good will be martyred, the Holy Father will have much to suffer, various nations will be annihilated. However, She prophesised:

"In the end My Immaculate Heart will Triumph."

The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to Me, and she will be converted, and a period of peace will be granted to the world. (July 13, 1917).

Mary promised special graces at the hour of our death to all who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months:

- 1) Go to Confession and receive Holy Communion.
 - 2) Recite five decades of the Rosary and ...
 - 3) Keep her company for at least 15 minutes by meditating on some aspect of the mysteries of the Rosary, all with the intention of making reparation to her Immaculate Heart.

World Apostolate of Fatima members may take advantage of the spiritual privileges associated to authentic devotees of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Our Lady promised to release from Purgatory soon after death all those who:

- 1) Wear a Brown Scapular.
- 2) Observe chastity according to their state in life.

You must be invested in the Brown Scapular and try to live a Christian Life.
